- Net operating cash outflows for the quarter were \$1.8m.
- Cash flows in any quarter may be affected by the timing of distributions of a share of revenue to customers. Receipts from Customers for the quarter include a net outflow of \$1.6m of revenue share due to customers with \$1.1m relating to prior quarters.
- The company incurred restructuring costs of \$0.2m associated with closure of its Scotland based office which was completed during the quarter.
