## NICKEL HUNT GATHERS PACE WITH COPERNICUS DRILLING UNDERWAY

Nickel exploration in Western Australia's East Kimberley region is gathering momentum, with Thundelarra Exploration Limited ("Thundelarra") (ASX: **THX**) today announcing the start of a 3,000-metre RC drilling program at the **Copernicus North** discovery, located 100 metres along strike from the Copernicus sulphide resource (241,000 tonnes at 1.5% nickel).

Sally Malay Mining Ltd ("Sally Malay") (ASX: SMY) are earning 60% of the 1.2 sq km Copernicus tenement by completing a bankable feasibility study. Sally Malay's current drilling is designed to follow up significant drill results intersected at Copernicus North last year. The first hole drilled into the prospect intersected 3 metres at 2.75% nickel and 1.36% copper from 144 metres with a best interval of 1 metre at 4.5% nickel.

The Copernicus joint venture is a key element in Thundelarra's three-pronged assault on nickel exploration in the East Kimberley, which also includes a major joint venture with LionOre Mining International Limited ("LionOre") (ASX:LIM) and Thundelarra's sole funded exploration.

LionOre are earning 60% of approximately half of Thundelarra's 2,800 sq kms in the East Kimberley by spending \$5 million over 5 years (see attached Joint Venture Tenement map). LionOre has commenced geophysical testing on a number of targets within the joint venture area. A drilling program will start after the completion of the geophysical surveys.

Thundelarra's work on its 100%-owned nickel-copper exploration ground in the East Kimberley has been progressing quickly with nine new targets already identified. Ground electro magnetic surveys are currently underway and drilling is planned for July-August. The new discoveries include outcropping gossan occurrences which have returned strongly anomalous rock chip samples of up to 2.03% nickel, 4.91% copper, and 4.42 g/t platinum + palladium + gold.

Thundelarra together with our joint venture partners have commenced the most intensive phase of nickel exploration in the East Kimberley since the 1970s and will spend a combined total of approximately \$3.5 million on exploration this year.
