Appointment of Key Roles

Cassini Resources Limited (ASX:CZI) (“Cassini” or the “Company”) is pleased to announce the appointment of several key team members to facilitate the exploration and development of the West Musgrave Project (the “Project”) following the successful completion of the acquisition of the Project from BHP Billiton Limited (“BHP Billiton”).

Executive Director Changes

Greg Miles, currently a Non-executive Director of Cassini, will assume the role of Executive Director - Technical.

Greg has extensive experience in the discovery, exploration and delineation of mineral resources across a wide range of commodities and provinces, including gold, iron ore and base metal deposits and has led many project teams through the Definitive Feasibility Study phase.

Greg led the Company’s technical diligence team involved in the assessment of the Project, and was significant in the decision to pursue the acquisition.

As a consequence of the West Musgrave Project now being the primary operational focus for Cassini, US-based David Johnson will resign as a Director of the Company, effective 30 June 2014. David will continue to oversee and manage the Company’s US projects. The Board thanks David for his contributions as a Director and look forward to his continued association with the Company.

Exploration Manager

Zoran Seat BScGeol (Hons), PhD (Geol), MAIG

Zoran is a geologist with a strong technical background in nickel exploration, and significant experience in the management, leadership and execution of exploration strategies. For the past 3 years, Zoran has been the Exploration Manager for Norilsk Nickel Australia where he was responsible for all of Norilsk’s Australian nickel, gold and base metal exploration activities. Prior to his current role, he fulfilled various exploration roles with BHP Billiton Minerals Exploration, Hancock Prospecting, BHP Billiton Nickel West and Mincor Resources NL.

Zoran has a Bachelor of Science in Geology (Hons) and a PhD in Geology, both from the University of Western Australia. Significantly, Zoran’s PhD thesis focussed on Nebo-Babel, examining the geology and Ni-Cu-PGE mineralisation of the Nebo-Babel intrusion. Following completion of his PhD, Zoran worked as a Geoscientist for BHP Billiton at the West Musgrave Project.

Ben Grguric BScGeol (Hons); PhD (Earth Sciences)

Ben is an economic geology technical specialist, with 20 years of operational, exploration and business development experience. His specialty areas include nickel deposits, geometallurgy, mineralogy and petrology.

Ben has worked in a number of senior roles in WMC Resources, BHP Billiton Minerals Exploration, Western Metals, and as Geoscience Manager Australia for Norilsk Nickel Australia.

In his time at BHP Billiton, Ben was instrumental in unravelling the complex geology and mineralogy of the Mt Keith nickel deposit and the development of the mineral processing strategy at Mt Keith. Ben is regarded as a world leader in deposit mineralogy and its link with processing technology, particularly disseminated low-grade nickel sulphide deposits. His work at Mt Keith was critical in transforming the operation into a highly profitable mine. Ben is a Fellow of the Society of Economic Geologists and the Australian Institute of Geoscientists.
