ISSUE OF SECURITIES AND S708A NOTICE

HIGHLIGHTS

- **Capital raising completed, including both placement and Share Purchase Plan**
- **Over \$7.1m raised to progress the West Musgrave Project**

Summary

Cassini Resources Limited (ASX: CZI) ("Cassini" or "the Company") advises that it has successfully allotted and issued the securities associated with the recently completed share purchase plan ("SPP") and the second tranche of the recent placement, to raise a total of over \$7.1 million.

New shares issued under the SPP and tranche 2 of the placement will rank equally with existing CZI shares. An Appendix 3B in respect of the SPP and tranche 2 placement securities issued is enclosed.

The funds raised under the SPP, together with the funds raised pursuant to the placement announced in April, will be used by Cassini to undertake the following:

- Completion of the Pre-Feasibility Study for the Nebo-Babel Project;
- Selected drill targeting of known higher grade zones at Nebo-Babel;
- Drill testing of the significant DHEM anomaly at the Succoth Prospect; and
- Provide for the general working capital requirements of the Company.
