Re: Request for Trading Halt

Hutchison Telecommunications (Australia) Limited (ACN 003 677 227) (“Hutchison Australia”) (ASX: HTA) requests that an immediate trading halt be granted with respect to Hutchison Australia’s securities pending an announcement to the market in relation to the Federal Court judgment regarding the proposed merger between Vodafone Hutchison Australia Pty. Ltd. (“VHA”) and TPG Telecom Limited (“TPG Telecom”) (ASX: TPG).

For the purposes of Listing Rule 17.1, Hutchison Australia provides the following information:

1. Hutchison Australia requests that the trading halt continue until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market in relation to the Federal Court judgment and the commencement of normal trading on 17 February 2020; and
2. Hutchison Australia is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted, or of any other information available at this stage that is necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
