#### **Cleansing Statement – Issue of Placement Shares**

Resonance Health Ltd (**ASX: RHT**) (**Resonance** or the **Company**) advises that 10,000,000 new fully paid ordinary shares in the Company have been issued via a placement, at a price of 5 cents per share, to sophisticated investors raising a total of \$500,000 before costs.

Resonance gives this notice pursuant to Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (**Corporations Act**).

#### **Secondary Trading Exemption**
