



Production Update – March 2021 Quarter

Highlights:

- **Thalanga Operations produced 3,068 tonnes copper concentrate, 6,959 tonnes zinc concentrate & 1,613 tonnes lead concentrate**
 - **Hillgrove Gold Mine produced 667oz of gold (261oz in doré and 406oz in concentrates) as ramp up continues**

Red River Resources Limited (ASX: RVR) is pleased to provide an update on March quarter (Q3 FY21) production at its Thalanga Operations in Queensland and Hillgrove Gold Mine, NSW.

Thalanga Operations (QLD):

Thalanga Operations produced 3,068 tonnes copper concentrate, 6,959 tonnes zinc concentrate & 1,613 tonnes lead concentrate during the quarter.

RVR stopped mining activities in the Far West mine from 27 March to 1 April for an investigation into a safety incident; there were no injuries or equipment damage. The investigation was completed and mine production resumed on 1 April and has returned to normal. The process plant drew down on ore stockpiles held on the ROM pad to continue production during this period.

Hillgrove Gold Mine (NSW):

RVR continued to ramp up production during the quarter, with 667oz of gold produced in doré and concentrates from the Bakers Hill stockpile as part of Stage 1 operations.

Low grade ore was processed in January and February as the mill was brought online and gravity gold concentrate leaching commenced at the end of February. RVR has poured 261oz of gold (in doré) which has been sold. The flotation concentrate produced to date contains 406oz of gold.

Further details will be available in the full March Quarterly Report to be released later this month.
