Tempo awarded works with CBH Group

Tempo Australia Limited (ASX: TPP) today announced it has secured a binding Letter of Award with CBH Group valued at an estimated \$6 million.

Tempo secured works with CBH Group for the supply of upgrade works to enhance throughput speeds at CBH Group grain handling facilities across Western Australia. The current scope of works is valued at approximately \$6 million and covers mechanical, electrical and civil services. Works are due to commence immediately and scheduled to be completed prior to the 2018 grain handling season (which typically commences in October).

The binding Letter of Award is based on a current draft contract, and allows works to begin immediately, with the final contract terms to be executed in less than two weeks. CBH Group and Tempo have been working closely together on this upgrade program and will conduct the works in a collaborative, relationship-based manner, using open book mechanisms to ensure a productive, cost-effective and timely completion of the works.

Tempo Chief Executive Officer Ian Lynass said "We are pleased to be working with CBH Group upgrade program of their grain handling facilities. We will utilise our leading productivity-focused technology to deliver agreed outcomes for this project in support of our valued customer.
