Furthermore, **mixed content modules** are now available to create, with users able to upload different document formats and videos in the same lesson.

In order to make the platform more user-friendly for HR managers and management, Velpic has added a **Skills Matrix** function that allows HR departments to view the status of all employees skills and training requirements in one place.

Perhaps most importantly, is the launch of the **Velpic developer site** that provides information about how to integrate the Velpic platform (using its Application Programming Interface, API) into other existing software systems, such as an internal HR management tool. This will significantly streamline the process of skills management for a business and provide HR departments with a full view of all employees and their training requirements. A number of customers have already utilised this feature and incorporated the Velpic platform into their internal systems.
