## Request for Trading Halt – E&P Financial Group Limited (ASX:EP1)

E&P Financial Group Limited (**EP1**) requests the immediate implementation of a trading halt (**Trading Halt**) to be applied to its ordinary shares in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, EP1 provides the following information in support of its request:

- a) the Trading Halt is requested pending the release of an announcement to ASX regarding the Federal Court of Australia settlement approval hearing scheduled for today, 3 April 2024, in relation to the representative proceeding filed by Shine Lawyers against Dixon Advisory & Superannuation Services Pty Ltd (Administrators Appointed), EP1, Mr Alan Dixon, and Mr Christopher Brown;
- b) EP1 requests that the Trading Halt continue until the earlier of:
  - i. such time as EP1 releases an announcement to ASX regarding the representative proceeding; or
  - ii. the commencement of trading on Friday 5 April 2024; and
- c) EP1 is not aware of any reason why the Trading Halt should not be granted, nor is it aware of any other information available at this stage that is necessary to inform the market about the Trading Halt.
