Ravenswood Expansion Project (REP)

Current status and continuous improvement

Current status:

- 13 year mine life, 1.8Moz in reserves
- Processing plant capacity of 5Mtpa
- Currently operating at 2.8Mtpa from Mt Wright (underground) and Nolans East (open pit)
- Re-opening two open pits:
 - Buck Reef West: 524koz reserve (18.3Mt @ 0.9g/t Au)
 - Sarsfield: 1.17Moz reserve (47.1Mt @ 0.8g/t Au)
- Received environmental and heritage approval to re-commence open pit mining at Sarsfield

Continuous improvement:

- Owner operator, larger equipment potential to drive lower mining costs
- Beneficiation of low grade ore (0.3-0.7g/t Au) providing additional production ounces and mine plan flexibility
- Drill testing high grade underground mining potential at Buck Reef Deeps
- Satellite high grade brownfields exploration upside potential

Bibiani Gold Mine Phase 2 drilling success

- A substantial gold deposit:
 - Production to date of >4Moz
 - 1.8Moz Total Resource
- Phase 2 drilling underway to upgrade inferred resources to an indicated category
- Phase 2 drilling has intersected mineralisation better than the inferred resource predicted
- Currently drilling to extend mine life beyond the initial five years
- Targeting 100kozpa, 10 year mine life, 25% IRR
